CALL FOR 16 SCHOLARSHIPS TO ATTEND THE MASTER DEGREE IN COMPUTER & ELECTRONIC ENGINEERING

The **University of Trieste**, in partnership with the *Regione Friuli Venezia Giulia*, *Confindustria Venezia Giulia* and *Ordine degli Ingegneri della Provincia di Trieste*, and with the sponsorship of twelve Companies (Amped, CGN, Cluster Reply, Cybertec, Danieli Automation, Esteco, Fincantieri, Innova, Solari Udine, Telit, U-blox, Wärtsila), is offering **16 scholarships** addressed to students willing to attend the **Master Degree (MD)** in **Computer & Electronic Engineering**.

The gross scholarship amount is **2.800 Euro** for the first year; during the second year the student will be involved in a collaboration with the Company that is supporting the scholarship.

1 – Scope

The scholarship is intended to form excellent master-degree engineers, with a solid background on hard and soft skills. The call is for graduated students of any nationality (Bachelor Degree), or for students that are going to acquire a bachelor degree within the Fall semester of 2017. The applicants need to satisfy the following requisites.

2 – Requisites

- a) Bachelor degree, acquired since no more than one year, and with a minimum grade of **9/10** (or equivalent).
- b) Students that are going to accomplish the Bachelor Degree during the fall semester of 2017
 - with no more than **20 ECTS** missing at the moment of application;
 - and
 - with an average weighted grade on all the exams of at least **8.66/10** (or equivalent).

3 – Deadline

The deadline to apply is **July, 31st - 2017**

To apply, please fill the Application Form, sign it and send a PDF scan to the following e-mail

Application forms received after the deadline will be rejected.

Together with the application form, it is necessary to enclose:

- a. copy of an identity card;
- b. *curriculum vitae et studiorum* in the European format;
- c. motivation letter;
- d. self-certification of all the exams done and the corresponding grades, weighted average of all the grades and total number of ECTS acquired;
- e. self-certification of the final grade obtained with the Bachelor Degree (only for students who already accomplished the degree).

4 – Candidates selection

The applications will be evaluated by a selection commission, that will be nominated on the 1st of August, and will conclude the pre-evaluation within the 22nd of August. The selection of the candidates is based on two phases:

- a) pre-selection of candidates admitted to the second phase;
- b) individual oral interviews with the pre-selected candidates.

The individual interviews will be held with representatives of the Companies that are offering the scholarships, and/or with the coordinator of the Master Degree, within the last week of August and the first week of September. The schedule of the interviews will be published between the 21st and the 25th of August 2017 on the web page <http://www.units.it/laureati/premi-di-studio>. It will not be sent personal communications to the candidates. The individual oral interviews for non-Italian candidates will be held in English in person, or by a remote Skype connection.

The commission judgement is definitive.

The names of the selected candidates will be published on the “Albo Ufficiale di Ateneo”, on the web page <http://web.units.it/premi-studio> within 5 working days since the date of the last oral interview. The selected students have to confirm by e-mail the acceptance of the scholarship within **September 10th 2017**, at the address dirittoallostudio@amm.units.it.

5 – Grant of the scholarship

The scholarship covers the fees for the first year of the Master Degree. The student who accepts the scholarship is requested to participate to the activities suggested by the sponsorship Company;



these activities will be developed during the two years of the MD and will culminate with an internship, and/or a thesis in a shared laboratory, and/or other solutions suggested by the coordinator of the MD and by the representative of the Company.

Should some scholarships will not be assigned, it will be defined a new call within January 31st 2018; this eventuality will be communicated by the "Albo Ufficiale di Ateneo" within the end of September 2017.

The payment of the scholarship is subordinated to the accomplishment of at least **2/3** of the ECTS within the end of each academic year. It is a commitment for the student to actively participate to the activities suggested by the Company that is supporting the scholarship, up to the end of the Master Degree; if this does not happen, the scholarship will be cut by 30%.

The UniTS Administration can check, at any time, the correctness of the auto-certifications provided by the candidates; in case of false declaration, the scholarship will be cancelled.

6 – Fiscal treatment

For Italian tax-payers, with reference to the provisions of art. 50 T.U.I.R, income from scholarships, allowances, awards and subsidies paid for study purposes are income earned by an employee's income.

7 – Treatment of personal data (D. Lgs. 30.06.2003 n. 196)

Personal data required for application are mandatory, and are treated following the provisions of D. Lgs. 196/03 and further modifications. In the case some data are missing, the candidate will be excluded by the selection. The holder for personal data treatment is the University of Trieste, in the person of its legal representative, the Rector.
